Dear Marina Manager,

Please be advised that the Harbor Master's Office will begin issuing warning stickers the week of July 16, 2018 to all boaters who do not have a 2018 Waterway Sticker on their vessel. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Any boat found in the water without a 2018 waterway user sticker will be subject to fines of 120% of the amount owed per order of an issuance of a Violation Notice by the Harbormaster demanding 120% of the amount owed according to Town By-law 145-16.

The Waterway User Fee is directed to all boaters who use Fairhaven waters for 14 days or more and are in the following categories: any boats 16' in length or more that are considered commercial or recreational and use boatyards, private slips and moorings. All small and large commercial vessels must display a sticker on their stern or wheelhouse (Lg. commercial F/V) indicating the fee has been paid in full for the season. Canoes, kayaks, inflatable, and trailered boats are exempt.
